A comprehensive seating range comprising armchair, two- and three-seat sofas, benches and low tables, all with underframes of fine-brushed stainless steel. Internal frames are of FSC-accredited beech and panel construction with elastic webbed seats; upholstery is of graded cmhr foams. Seat and back cushions are Dacron-wrapped cmhr foam. Fabric or leather upholstery with top-stitched detailing. Standard table tops are of toughened acid-etched glass; optional tops of maple veneer or black slate may be specified at extra cost.



Fred Scott 1942 - 2001

Following in his father's footsteps, Fred Scott served his apprenticeship as a cabinet-maker in High Wycombe before gaining a scholarship to the Royal College of Art in 1963. Widely regarded as the most talented British furniture designer of his generation, his career was dogged by recurring illness. As a freelance designer, his reputation was firmly established with his Supporto series for Hille in 1979; later in his career he worked closely with Hitch Mylius to develop hm25 and other upholstery designs.
